Rules: Official UKC Nosework Rulebook Effective
January 1, 2017 will be followed at this event.

Awards: Placement ribbons, qualifying ribbons,
High In Trial, High In Trial Junior, and New Title
ribbons will be awarded.

Crating:

There will be limited indoor crating at this event.
Tarps must be placed under all crates and chairs.
Dogs must be crated except when going out to
potty, working in the designated practice area, or
when proceeding to the search area.

Walking on Show Grounds:

While walking on show grounds, all dogs must be
kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet in length.
Dogs should be kept a reasonable distance (8-10
feet) apart. Additional space if desired. A Nosework
trial is not an activity where dogs should socialize.
Longer lines or flexi leashes may be used during
search, but when not searching need to be reduced
to a length of no more than six feet. Handlers will
be given time to change leashes, if needed, before
their search.
